

## YMYC VISITOR MOORING

<b>Guidance for members using the visitor pontoon.</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Visitors should fly the club burgee whilst moored on the club pontoon</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Visitors should moor economically ie;</li><li>• Pull to the front of the pontoon if arriving first and subsequent arrivals should moor as close as practicable to the vessel in front.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Visitors should accept/ welcome boats alongside during busy periods and leave fenders out for subsequent visitors.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Boats must not be left unattended overnight on the visitor pontoon.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All vessels must have current insurance and a river licence.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Any visitor wanting an electric card or top up should ask a member of the Mooring Committee (contact details in club handbook).</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Boats moored on the visitor pontoon may be asked to move up to accommodate vessels wanting fuel.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Children must wear life jackets on the visitor pontoon</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Engines and generators must not be run whilst moored on the club pontoon.</li></ul>
